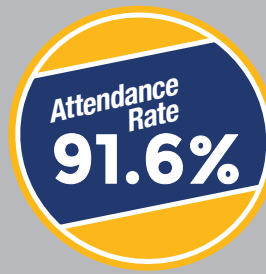

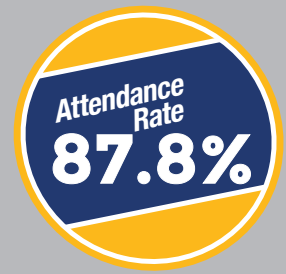

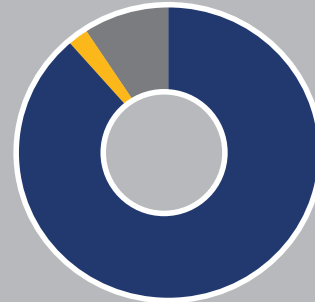

Demographic Chart

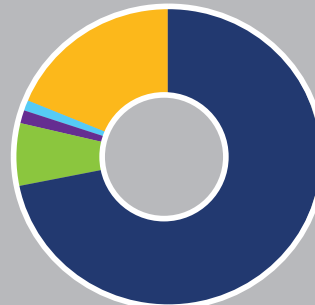

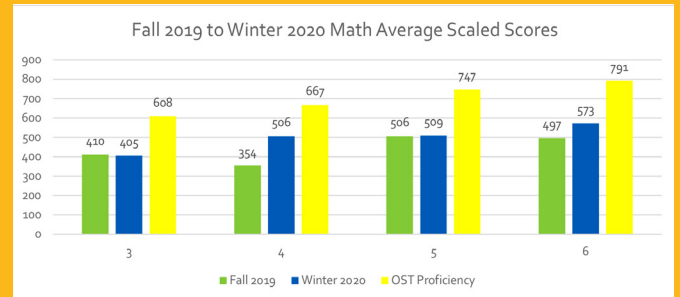
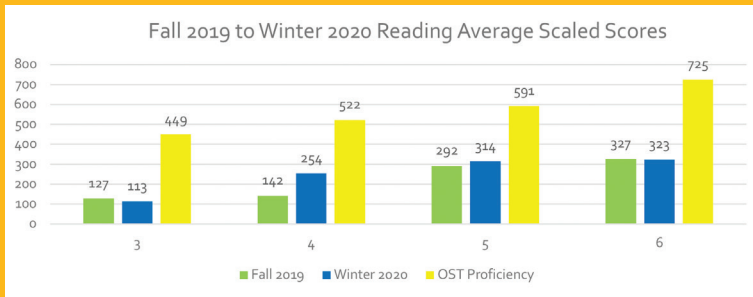
