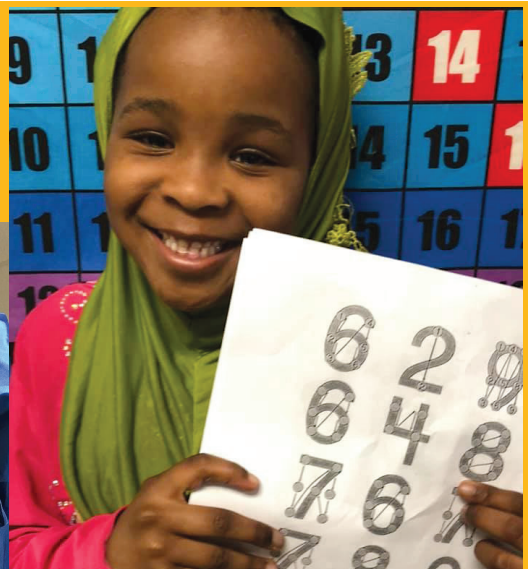

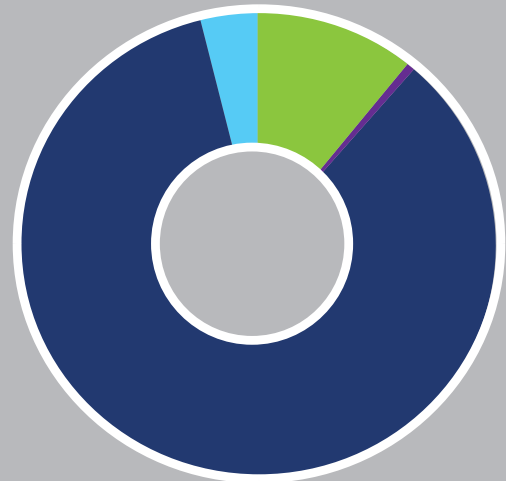

Demographic Chart

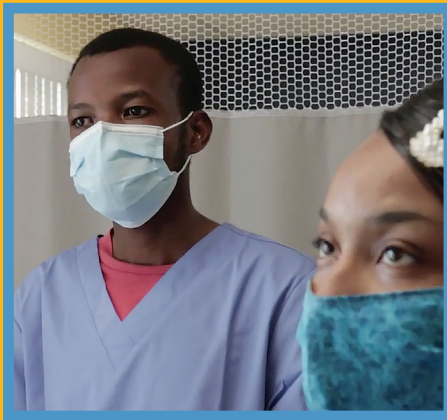

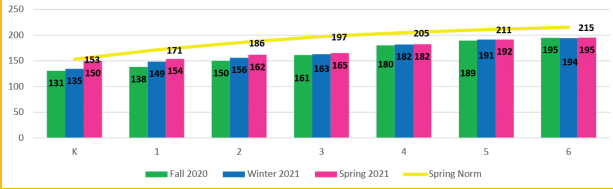

- Partnered with the Hilltop Library to host a Literacy Night.

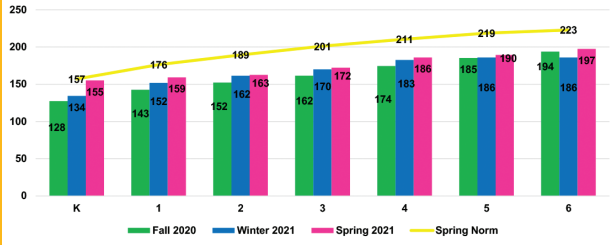


Elementary Academic Testing

Average Reading RIT Scores: Fall 20 to Spring 21

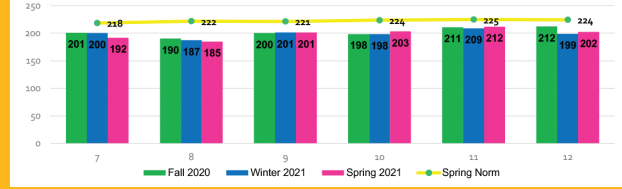


Average Math RIT Scores: Fall 20 to Winter 21

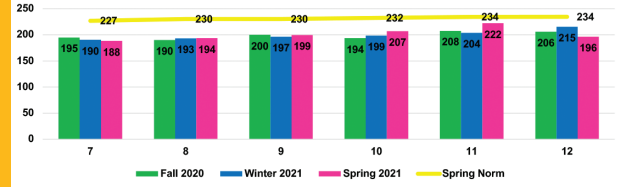


High School Academic Testing
