

Steps to Apply

- 1 Determine student's eligibility
 - Available to students between the ages of 3–22 whose school has identified them as a child with autism
- Find a participating provider* and apply
 - There are more than 200 participating providers statewide
 - Contact providers to visit, meet staff and apply
- Once the provider accepts the student, the parent submits a scholarship application to the provider
 - To be awarded a scholarship, the student must have a finalized Individualized Education Program (IEP) from their district of residence
- 4 Award letter sent to families
